The Brazen Altar represents Calvary, the place of redemption, sanctification, justification, and propitiation, by the Lord Jesus Christ, Our Perfect Lamb Sacrifice, once and for all men, once and for all sin, once and for all time.

By His Blood we have bold access to the Holy of Holies, the Throne of Grace, and to Our Father. His righteousness and holiness is imputed to us, that is, credited to our account.

This is the place of identification with Him, and His finished work of the Cross on our behalf. Here, we identify with His death and burial, and with His resurrection life, which is imparted to us by our faith (trust) on Him, making us a New Creation by His sacrifice.

Here, in our daily faithwalk and ministry to the Lord as priests and kings unto Him, we honor and worship Him for His sacrifice, His work, His Blood
